BARRETT, Lewis. Born 7 Jun 1752 in Han.; entered service 1776 as minute man under Col. Meredith, Col. Chas. Dabney & Capt. James Dabney; at Hampton to protect citizens & property from Gov. Dunmore's predatory incursions. [Pen.]

BARTLETT, Hastin. Enlisted Feb. 1776 from NC; then drafted as militiaman from Han.; under Col. Wm. Dandridge at Yorktown. [Pen.]

BETTISWORTH, Richard. Enlisted 1776 under Capt. Richard Cluff Anderson; m. Elizabeth; d. 9 Nov 1825. [Pen.]

BLACKWELL, David. Born 24 Aug 1764 near Newcastle; ent. service under Capt. John Stanley in 1779 as substitute for John Blackwell; "I was accepted by Capt.
